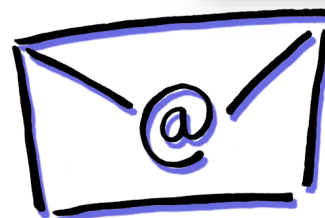
SOCIAL BRIDGE

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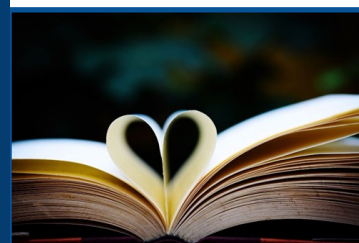
PRESCOTT MAC USERS GROUP (PMUG*) in partnership w/OLLI

Sedona In Person Options

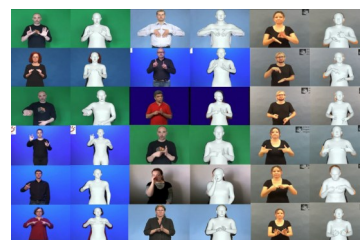
OLLI SEDONA•VERDE VALLEY BOOK CLUB
